



## Bradley Allan Nelson

August 28, 1955 - December 20, 2013

Bradley Allan Nelson, age 58, of Dassel, died Friday, December 20, 2013, at his home in Dassel. A memorial service will be held on Monday, December 23, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. at Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel with the Rev. Steven Olson officiating. The interment of the urn will be held at a later date.
