



## Bruce Darrel Lindquist

September 26, 1944 - December 23, 2018

Bruce Darrel Lindquist, age 74, of Dassel, passed away on Sunday, December 23, 2018, at his home.

Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, January 5, 2019, at 11:00 A.M. at the Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel with Rev. Laurie O'Shea officiating.

Bruce Darrel Lindquist, was born September 26, 1944, in French Lake Township, Wright County, Minnesota, the son of Elmer and Ruby (Nelson) Lindquist. Bruce grew up in the Cokato and Dassel area and graduated from the Dassel High School in 1962. Bruce was baptized in the Christian faith and was a member of Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel.

Bruce worked at the Minnesota Hatchery in Dassel for 28 years and worked as a finishing carpenter for Dahl Builders for 11 years.

Hobbies he enjoyed were hunting, fishing and woodworking. Together, Bruce and Renva enjoyed antiquing road trips throughout Minnesota. Bruce enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren for family gatherings, sports events and holidays. He was always willing to lend a helping hand to family and neighbors. He took meticulous care of his yard and garden. He loved the companionship of his English Setters, Daisy, Maggie and Mollie and would often tell stories about them. Bruce will be missed by his family and many friends.

Bruce is survived by his wife, Renva Lindquist of Dassel, three sons, Clint (Brenda) Lindquist of Litchfield, Heath Lindquist of Wyoming, Minnesota, Daniel (Shannon) Lindquist of South Haven, 11 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren, sisters, Betty Rokala of Cokato, Diane (David) Chastek of South Haven, and Mary (John) Railsback of Silt, Colorado. He is also survived by several nieces, nephews and other relatives.
