



## Franklin Allen Renner

Franklin Allen Renner, age 83, of Milbank, South Dakota, formerly of Dassel and Kingston area passed away at the Avantara Milbank Nursing Home in Milbank, South Dakota. A service will be held on Saturday, December 16, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. at the Kingston Community Center in Kingston, MN.

Frank enjoyed watching the Minnesota Vikings and the Minnesota Twins. He had been a member of the Kingston American Legion for many years.
