



## Gladys Wyoma Milner

October 4, 1919 - October 25, 2021

Gladys Wyoma Milner, age 102, of Dassel, died Monday, October 25, 2021, at the Lakeside Generations in Dassel. A funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, November 12, 2021, at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Dassel with Pastor Darren Olson Officiating. The interment will be held on a later date at Mount Olive Cemetery in Hillsboro, Oregon.
