Hazel Darlene Prins, age 94, of Dassel formerly of Hutchinson and Worthington, died Tuesday, August 29, 2023, at Park Nicollet Methodist Hospital in Saint Louis Park, Minnesota. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 9, 2023, at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Dassel with Rev. Keith Carlson officiating the service. In 1991, upon retirement, Hazel and Gary purchased a home on Lake Jennie near Dassel, Minnesota.

Hazel loved to fish, was a wonderful cook who enjoyed cooking and serving others. She loved watching the Minnesota Twins, reading recipes, sewing, and making quilts for family and friends. She loved her family with her whole heart, her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren were the love of her life. She will be deeply missed by her family and friends.
