Jean Marie Holm, age 86, of Dassel, died Thursday, July 11, 2019, at her home. Jean attended Litchfield High School where she graduated in 1950.

an agent and board member of Crow River Mutual Insurance Company.

She was an avid card player and enjoyed getting together with her Golden Age Card Club. She was also a Senior Expo Volunteer. She had volunteered to drive numerous people to their doctor's appointments over the years. She enjoyed her family, especially during the holidays and special events. She especially enjoyed her grandchildren and great grandchildren. Each year, she hosted all of her kids, grandkids, and great grandkids at a family weekend. This was the highlight of her year and speaks to her overwhelming generosity and belief in the importance of family. She loved to serve and gave of herself in ways that made other's lives a little easier and better.

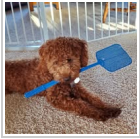
