Judy Ann Larson, age 69, of Cokato, died Tuesday, January 15, 2019, at the St. Cloud Hospital. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, January 19, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. at the Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel with the Rev. Laurie O'Shea officiating.

She loved her horses and particularly loved her paint "Tucker". She shared a love of classical cars with her husband and sister. She enjoyed her 1967 Ford Mustang. She was always a caregiver, having taken care of her mother for many years. She was always there for her family and always had a spot in her heart for her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

She is survived by her husband, Milton of Cokato, three children, Jessica of Hubbard, Mitchell (Jennie) of Braham, and Jackie of Maple Lake, nine grandchildren, six great grandchildren, sisters, Jeannie Tessmer of Hutchinson, Jocelyn (Brad) Larson of Lexington, Nebraska; Jennifer (Gail) Plaisance of Buffalo Lake, sisters-in-law, Joyce Barrick of Hutchinson, and Nina Barrick of Litchfield.
