Lowell Jerry Peterson Jr., age 76, of Dassel, died Saturday, May 22, 2021, at Regions Hospital in St. Paul. A funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, May 28, 2021, at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Dassel with Pastor Doug Pierce officiating. The interment will be held at the Lake Jennie Evangelical Covenant Church in rural Dassel.

There will be a visitation on Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Johnson Funeral Home in Dassel and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Lowell Jerry Peterson Jr. the son of Lowell Oscar and Lorane Elsie Elizabeth (Bergquist) Peterson was born on February 10, 1945, in Cokato, Minnesota. He especially enjoyed time with his twin brother, Steve, just sitting in the shop talking while having a pop.
