Lyndon Myron "Sonny" Nelson Jr., age 78. Of Dassel, died Sunday, February 19, 2023, at the Good Samaritan Society in Howard Lake. Sonny was extremely proud of his girls. He loved his family with his whole heart. He loved to spend time holidays and special events together celebrating with love and togetherness. He was an avid bird watcher and had even named the barn swallows. He took a great deal of time and effort in taking care of his home as he enjoyed having a home that looked well taken care of and neat. He was a talented man who could paint a barn quilt, weld a go-cart for his girls, make a swing set and teeter totter for children to play on. He would take the girls waterskiing behind the pontoon once the chores were finished. He loved to make Rice Crispy treats for family and friends. He enjoyed

entertaining and having friend and family over for food and conversation.

He is survived by his wife, Eunice “Nony” Nelson of Dassel, daughters, Jennifer (Toby) Hansen of Mesa, Arizona; and Jill (Chris) Renstrom of Hutchinson, two grandchildren, Zach Hansen and Nina Hansen, and one sister, Mary Nelson of Meridian, Idaho. he is also survived by other family and numerous friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Margaret and Lyndon Nelson Sr.

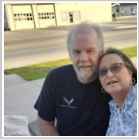
I'm grateful for those memories of love, acceptance and patient teaching, even when I'm sure Sonny was concerned about milk prices and his precious providers.
