Margaret Lenore (Beckman) Danielson, age 95, of Dassel, died Monday, January 19, 2026, at the Lakeside Generations. She especially enjoyed spending time together for the holidays and other family get togethers. She was daycare for many of her grandchildren over several years. Margaret was an active member of the Stockholm Lutheran Church, serving group for many funerals, and was on the pastoral call committee, prayer chain, and birthday club. Margaret will be missed by her family and her

many friends.
