Marilyn grew up in Richmond, Minnesota, where she was baptized and later received first communion at the Church of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Richmond. Marilyn was a member of the Gethsemane Lutheran Church at the time of her death. Marilyn graduated from Rocori High School in Cold Spring, Minnesota.

On June 26, 1971, Marilyn was united in marriage to Lawrence "Larry"

Schroeder at the Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Saint Cloud, Minnesota. Together they made their home in the Dassel area where she was employed as a waitress and hostess at Hojies Grill and Smokehouse and worked at Cenex in Cokato for many years, serving up the best broasted chicken.
