Marlene Joyce Walters, age 66, of Buffalo, passed away Thursday, December 29, 2022, peacefully in her home in Buffalo. A funeral service will be held on Friday, January 6, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. at the Plymouth Lutheran Church with Pastor Ryan Kandoll and Pastor Robert Tumberg officiating at the service. The interment will be held at the Kingston Apostolic Lutheran Church Cemetery.

Marlene continued her education at St. Cloud State and graduated in 1993 with a degree in elementary education. made their home for the last 27 years.

Marlene's light shone brightly in this world. Her infectious smile could light up a room, and her inner joy and exuberance for life overflowed on everyone around her and into everything she did. A gracious hostess and naturally creative, she loved organizing tea parties, relaxing at the cabin, and planting flowers in her garden. Her sense of humor and comedic timing made game nights uproarious and, paired with her compassion and empathy, could ease the deepest hurts. She loved her family with her whole heart, never missing an opportunity to communicate just how much, with gentle words and humble acts of service. Her grandchildren especially lit up her life—she loved crafting, baking, and exploring with them, and took every chance to let them know how loved they were. Her favorite way to start the day was with her morning devotions and a steaming cup of coffee in the quiet moments before the rest of the house woke up. Her love for Jesus permeated every aspect of her life, and the strength of her faith in her Savior never wavered, regardless of circumstances.
