Marlow Darrell Bergquist, age 86 of Dassel, passed away peacefully Sunday, August 1, 2021, at the Hutchinson Hospital. A memorial service will be held on Friday, August 6, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. at the Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel with Rev. Hollie Holt-Woehl officiating. The interment will be held at the Dassel Cemetery following the service.
