Mildred M. Hendrickson, age 97, of Dassel, died Wednesday, December 9, 2015, at the Augustana Lakeside Health Care of Dassel. She was active in the Evangelical Covenant Church Women serving for funerals and attending bible studies. She enjoyed the time that she would spend with her family for holidays and special events.
