Stuart Arnold Johnson, age 86, of Dassel, died Tuesday, October 29, 2024, at the Lakeside Health Care Center of Dassel. He enjoyed meeting and visiting with people and making them feel welcome. He dearly loved his immediate family and extended family and enjoyed the times spent with each of them. Although not enthusiastic about travel, he willingly came along and enjoyed many family trips.
